

**Electrical Applications
Adult Education Program
Warren County Technical School**

Class Schedule:

This program will run for 6 weeks, one Tuesday per week, starting on September 14th. Class will consist of both theory, and a hands-on component, followed up with a question and answer period.

Class Goals:

The goal of this class is to educate the students with a basic knowledge of a typical household wiring system. Students will also learn and understand the basic principles spelled out in the NEC to complete basic installations and repairs safely.

Books, Handouts, and NEC. Code books

Warren Tech. will provide information/hand-outs pertaining to the topic being taught. Students may use the NEC code books that we have in class, or they may choose to purchase their own code books.

Cost of Materials/Tools:

The cost of materials per student will be approximately \$65.00. This will be for expendable items (wire, boxes, and fasteners). Tools from the day class may be used, but Students would have the option to bring their own tools if they choose to do so.

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Tools needed for class:

- Hammer (electricians hammer preferred)
- Linesman pliers
- Diagonal cutting pliers
- Wire stripper
- Phillips screwdriver (number 2)
- Cabinet or straight blade screwdriver
- Utility knife

Note:

If there is an interest in a second class (part 2) to further their knowledge, and or allow for more hands-on time, I will consider a second 6 week class. Material cost, tools and number of weeks would remain the same as part 1 of this class.
