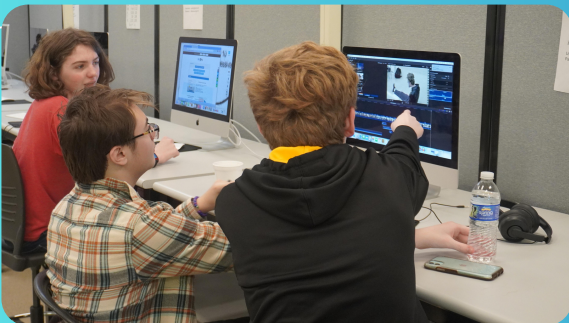


Get a huge head start on your career!
